Linda Sherrard, Director of Community Education presented a Power Point slideshow explaining the TEEG Grant application. Every year, this grant must be

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presented to the District Planning and Advisory Committee for approval before submission to TEA. If approved, the district could receive as much as \$320,000.000 annually by 2008-09. Four principals and/or their assistants represented their campus: Michelle Chae, WAMS; Billy Foster, CMS; Chris Griffin, NSMS; and JoAnn Garza, WAE. The committee was divided into four different groups for discussion and review of the grants. The groups were asked to check each plan to ensure that it met the requirements of the grant and for misspelled words, grammatical words, etc. Ms. Sherrard will review the FINAL grant applications before submitting them to TEA. Ms. Sherrard thanked the committee for their cooperation in this important grant submission.

Nominations were made for a DPAC chair representative for 2007-2008. Billie Briggs nominated Billy Foster and Linda Johnson closed the nominations. The committee elected Mr. Foster.
